Donating to libraries

We are grateful to receive teaching and assessment materials well as books that meet the library acquisition and collection policies and the aims and objectives of Dyslexia Action. As shelf space is limited, donated items must meet the following library standards:

- they are in good condition – not fading, yellowing, marked inside, with weak spines or loose or missing pages
- they are reasonably current
- they have a good standard of content and publisher – authoritative, subjects that are relevant to the library collection policy
- the librarian can dispose of them as they see fit – they may be offered to other libraries, sold, or otherwise disposed of.
