

Q. How much time will I spend preparing for teaching practice and learner assessments?  
A. Ongoing study of module content, background reading and preparation for teaching and assessing should be manageable within the 15-20 hours per week study time. You will, of course need to prepare the video recordings,

Q. How much time will I have to spend working with specified learners?

A. Learner 1: Weekly through terms one and two  
1 hour pre-teaching interview  
10 x 1 hour structured lessons - 2 of which are video recorded  
2 hour assessment - video recorded

Learner 2: Weekly through term three

1 hour pre-teaching interview  
2 hour assessment - video recorded  
1 hour preliminary specialist lesson  
6x 90 minute lessons (1 hour plus 30 minutes or 2 x 45 minutes per week) - 1 of which is video recorded

Q. Does this have to be one on one or can it be part of a group lesson?

It is all 'one to one' work during the certificate course

Q. Is there any other part of the course that will need to be done during school time?

A. Study time is a minimum of 15-20 hours per week average through the course, including holiday periods, and as, once qualified, you will be a valuable resource for your school, it would be helpful if you could negotiate some non-contact time for some of these hours.
